

Sattva Group offers oxygen bus on wheels to offset Karnataka access to oxygen for needy patients

Sattva Group a real estate company in association with Greenwood High International School, and Maharaja Agrasen Hospital, Bengaluru has come up with a timely initiative to launch five sophisticated buses which will provide free oxygen to people waiting to get a bed outside city hospitals. Each bus has been redesigned to accommodate 12 patients at any given time.

With this tie-up with Maharaja Agrasen Hospital in Padmanabhanagar, Bengaluru patients can have some respite in their time of dire need. Each patient will have to provide his or her doctor prescription or RT-PCR report and a copy of his or her Aadhaar card, to avail the free oxygen facility.

"We plan to see how this initiative goes for the next ten days and then we will scale up to 10 buses thereafter.. Each patient will be able to use the oxygen for 2 hours and will also be given a free nasal canula for the oxygen flow and will also be connected to the flow meter and regulator, stated Dr Satish Kumar Jain, representing Maharaja Agrasen Hospital.
